Gold Projects in Canada

Altair's primary project is the Kena Gold project near Nelson, BC. A 76 sq. km. project, Kena has a substantial NI 43-101 compliant gold resource. The property has an 8,000 m strike length. Altair can earn up to a 75% interest in the project from Sultan Minerals.



Kena lies 7 km south of Nelson. Highway 6 runs through the project allowing easy access. Water, power, skilled manpower are readily available. The project lies on a plateau and work can be done most months of the year

Sultan Minerals defined the 1.1 million gold resource in 2004. But with gold prices between \$300 and \$ 400 in that period, the project was not economic. With gold now about \$ 1,700, the economics of the project have changed. The project has had little work done since 2004 and Altair will undertake an extensive \$7.5 million work program over the next 4 years

The resource has been defined in the Gold Mountain and Kena zones, which have seen 16,500 meters of drilling. In addition, there is a large gold-copper target (Kena Copper zone) and old artisanal mines with high grade gold production over an 8,000 m strike length.

Altair has another gold project in northwest Ontario: the **Lobstick** project. With a favourable geological setting and the presence of widespread gold mineralization, Lobstick has the potential for the discovery of a significant gold system. The Rainy River project, Gold Canyon's Springpole project and the Hemlo deposit are also in northwest Ontario and have potentially similar geological settings
